At this event there will be 40 one hour workshops and 6 all day workshops. Workshops cover all aspects of church life and ministry. There is a wealth of wisdom to be gleaned! The Connectional Ministries office has recruited quality leadership from our conference and beyond. Gifted lay and clergy teachers will share their experience and provide ways for participants to share best practices from other churches too. Registration is required. It can be completed on line, or by sending in the form in the brochure. Childcare is available and lunch is included. This is quite a bargain for \$20.

I hope that we will be well represented at this training event. Consider giving up part of your Saturday to learn more about leading our church to a healthier future. This is a great way for our teams and committees to get new ideas and inspiration. The answers to our next problems might be right there for the taking. Help keep us on the path!
